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






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
TRAINING SESSION

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
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ATAL FDP:

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
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

It's Never Too Late: A Message to Students

"It is never too late to be what you might have been"

But here's a powerful truth: It's never too late to start, to change direction, or to pursue what truly matters to you. What really matters is the thought to start once again.

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Second, realize that the notion of being "too late" is a construct rather than an actual obstacle. However, the reality is that there are a ton of opportunities in the world for people in any stage of life. No matter when you take that initial step, it's crucial. Whether you're thinking of switching your major, taking up a new pastime, or even going in a totally different direction professionally, the first step is always the most crucial. It is well said that take the first step, rest the God will see.

Furthermore, you have valuable experiences and talents from your journey. Even though you're beginning from scratch, your prior experiences give you a distinct viewpoint and set of skills. Every step you take toward learning, no matter how late in life, contributes to your overall development.

Lastly, adopting a growth mentality is crucial. This entails viewing obstacles as chances to grow rather than as signs of failure. It's simple to get discouraged if you think you're "behind," but you can consider every encounter as a step forward if you adopt a mindset that prioritizes learning above deadlines. Ultimately, it's never too late to get started. Recall that your path is unique, whether you're thinking about changing your major, pursuing a different line of work, or just wishing to pursue a new hobby. When you choose to give up trying is the one moment when it is really too late. Thus, don't let the fear that it will be "too late" to prevent you from creating the future you want. Instead, take the first step.
