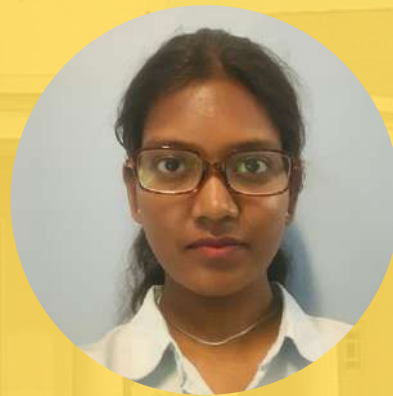

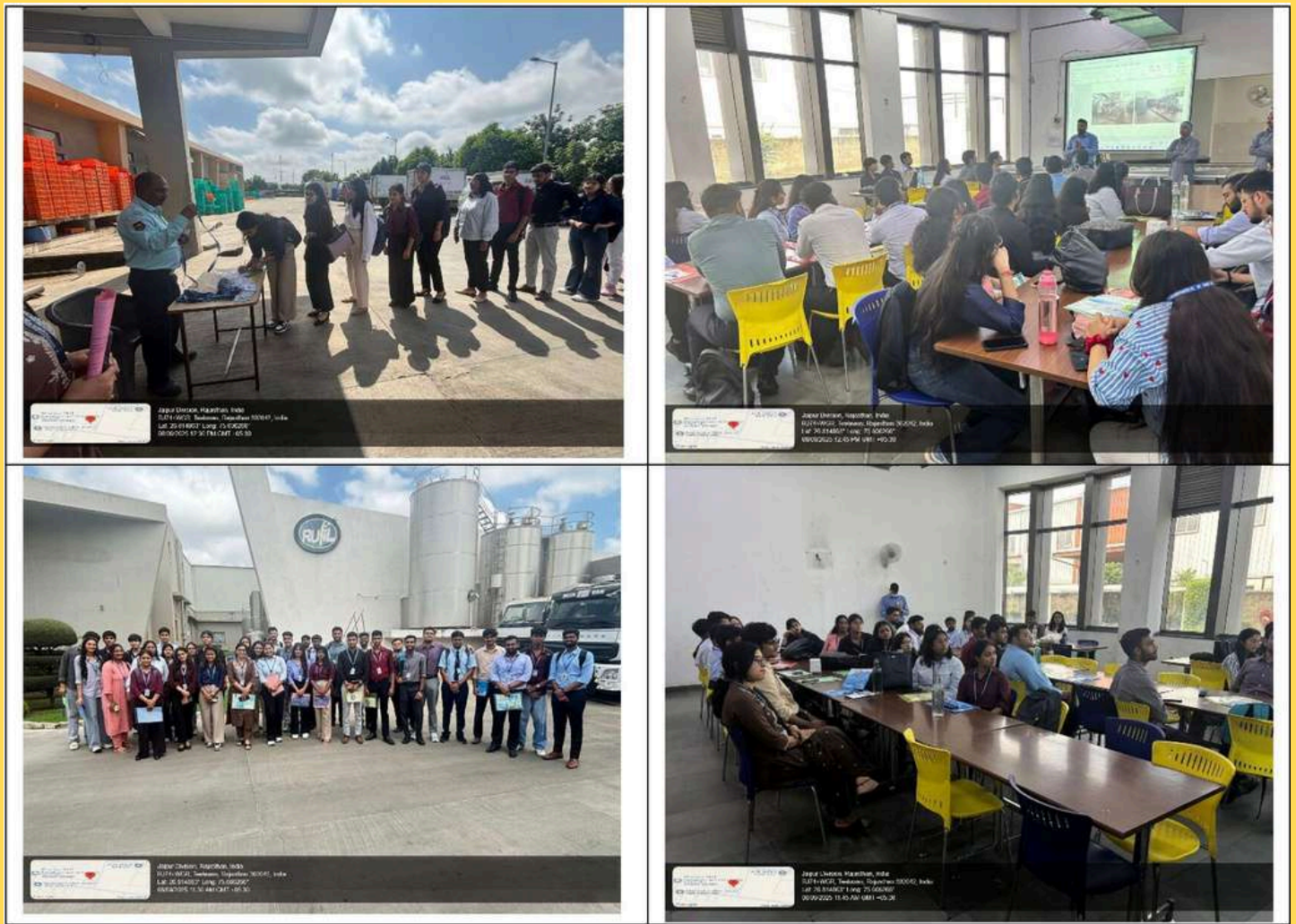
TEACHERS' DAY TRIBUTE
