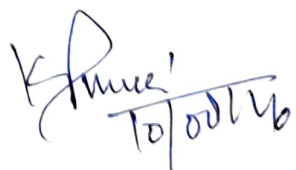


M.Sc. Physics

Program Outcomes (POs)
