45AC (A-2): Controller of Examinations

45AC (A-2-1): Proposal of New Question Paper Templates

- In order to enable Course Coordinators to design question papers in alignment with the specific nature of each course—while ensuring appropriate representation of Bloom's Taxonomy levels—a committee was constituted for this purpose. Based on its recommendations, the 12th Board of Examinations has proposed revised Question Paper (QP) templates.

The council gave approval of the above agenda item.

45AC (A-2-2): Proposal for inclusion of QR Code on Degree Certificates

- In compliance with the Rajasthan State Government mandate to print a QR code on degree certificates for authentication and to prevent potential unethical practices, the 12th Board of Examinations has recommended implementing this measure starting from the upcoming convocations.

The council gave approval of the above agenda item.

45AC (A-2-3): Proposal of discontinuation of Printed Semester-wise Grade Cards

- Following detailed deliberations in the Board of Examinations (BoE), it is proposed to discontinue the issuance of hard-copy semester-wise grade sheets for examinations conducted after July 2026, except in special cases.
Soft copies of grade sheets shall be made available to students through the SLCM portal immediately after the declaration of results. Additionally, one official hard-copy transcript will be issued to each student along with the degree certificate.

The council didn't give approval of the above agenda item with the following suggestions:

- The semester-wise grade cards must be distributed to the students in the classroom by the respective department before they are uploaded in the NAD portal.
- To be vigilant with the Degree Nomenclature which will be printed in the semester wise grade cards.
- The extra credit earned in case of Honours degree shall be reflected in the final semester grade card.
- The Final semester grade card and Transcript will incorporate any changes to be made in the previous semester grade cards and will be uploaded in the NAD portal.



45AC (A-2-4): Proposal of Course-wise Result Declaration and Credit Consideration for (S)GPA Calculation

- It is proposed that results be processed and declared course-wise immediately upon completion of evaluation.

Further, for the purpose of (S)GPA calculation, the total semester credits shall be considered irrespective of the number of course credits registered by the student.

The council approved the consideration of total semester credits for (S)GPA calculation but didn't give approval for course-wise result declaration with the suggestion that the last paper in the End Term Exam can be of an easy one.

45AC (A-2-5): Proposal of Ph.D. Degree Template

- To promote interdisciplinary research across existing faculties at MUJ, it is proposed that the Ph.D. degree be awarded in the name of the University rather than under individual faculties, as per the current practice.

- The Board of Examinations has proposed granting flexibility to course coordinators in designing question papers for Open Elective courses. Instead of adhering to the existing practice of preparing only MCQ-based question papers, coordinators may be permitted to design question papers in formats that align with the nature, objectives, and learning outcomes of the respective courses.

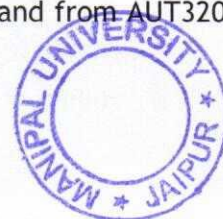
